Agenda Item 2 (Minute No. 11) - Members' Interests:

Agenda Item 3 (Minute No. 12) - Minutes

The Minutes of the Cabinet meeting held on 16.6.2021 were approved as a correct record.

Agenda Item 4 (Minute No. 13) - Forward Plan

To comply with regulations under the Localism Act 2011, the Leader presented a revised Forward Plan to the meeting which outlined key decisions likely to be taken within the next quarter of 2020. The Plan was reviewed each month.

Agenda Item 7 (Minute No. 16) - Climate Action Plan

Resolved:
